## Nov. 8 - Depart USA to Tel Aviv

Today we depart from the United States and fly to Tel Aviv, Israel. Meals will be served in flight.

## Nov. 9 – Arrive in Israel

Arrive in Ben Gurion International Airport in Tel Aviv. After securing our luggage, we will check into our hotel in Tiberius and enjoy our dinner and a good night's sleep.

## Nov. 10 - Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Golan Heights, Jordan River

Journey to Caesarea Philippi, where Peter proclaimed "You are the Christ" (Matthew 16). Visit Tel Dan, where Jeroboam set up a golden calf, and paganism took root in the 10 northern tribes of Israel and brought about its downfall (1 Kings 12). Stand on the Golan Heights and appreciate the strategic importance of this area overlooking the Sea of Galilee. Remember your baptism at the Yardenit Baptismal site, where the Jordan River exits the Sea of Galilee on its journey southward (Matthew 3).

## Nov. 11 – Nazareth, Nazareth Village, Cana, View Mt. Tabor, Fish Lunch, Boat Ride to Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, St. Peter's Primacy

Visit Nazareth, Jesus' boyhood home (Matthew 2: 23). Explore the Nazareth Village, a living presentation of the life, times, and teachings of Jesus of Nazareth. Recall Jesus' first miracle as you pass through Cana (John 2). Pass Mt. Tabor, the site of Deborah and Barak's victory over Sisera's army and the traditional place of the Transfiguration of Jesus. Enjoy a St. Peter's Fish Dinner at the Ein Gev kibbutz. Enjoy a special time of worship during our boat ride across the Sea of Galilee to Capernaum. Travel to the Mt. of Beatitudes, the traditional site where Jesus preached His Sermon



on the Mount (Matthew 5-7). You'll also visit the Chapel of the Primacy where three times Peter professed his devotion to the risen Christ (John 21).

## Nov. 12 – Megiddo, Mt. Carmel, Caesarea (Aqueduct and Hippodrome), Western Wall, Jerusalem Hotel

Travel to Megiddo and view the Valley of Armageddon (Rev. 16). Travel to Mt. Carmel where Elijah defeated the priests of Baal (1 Kings 18). Journey to Caesarea by the Sea and stand in the place where it is believed Paul addressed King Herod and Festus (Acts 25, 26). This port city reveals many extensive remains of the theatre and other sites, including a Roman aqueduct along the Mediterranean shore. Take time to pray at the Western Wall, part of the retaining wall of the ancient temple grounds. Arrive at our Jerusalem hotel for dinner and overnight.

## Nov. 13 - Model City, St. Peter in Gallicantu Church, Bethlehem, Pilate's Judgment Hall, Lithostrotos, Via Dolorosa

Visit the remarkable Model of Jerusalem as it was during the Roman occupation, which will help us understand what the city looked like during the time of our Lord. Walk through some of the ancient rooms of Caiaphas' the High Priest's house beneath the Church of St. Peter in Gallicantu. Here Jesus was held overnight before His crucifixion (Luke 22). This afternoon we will enter Bethlehem (Luke 2), the birthplace of our Lord. Look out on the Shepherd's Fields where angels spread the Good News, and enjoy shopping in one of the Bethlehem stores. Visit Pilate's Judgment Hall, followed by the Lithostrotos at the Convent of the Sisters of Zion. This area of pavement constructed with large slabs is associated with the condemnation of Jesus by Pilate. Walk the Via Dolorosa, "the Way of the Cross", and stand in reverence at the Church of the Holy Sepulchre.

## Nov. 14 - Upper Room, Mt. Zion, Jewish Quarter, Temple Institute Museum, Temple Mount, Pool of Bethesda, Mt. of Olives, Garden of Gethsemane, Dominus Flevit, City of David

Stand in the Upper Room, revered as the place of the Last Supper (Mark 14). Visit Mt. Zion. Walk through the Jewish Quarter, where modern buildings tower over excavations that date to the Judean Monarchy. See the Treasures of the Temple Museum and see replicas of the instruments used for worship and sacrifice. Visit the Temple Mount. View the Pool of Bethesda where Jesus performed the Sabbath Miracle. Stand atop the Mount of Olives as Jesus did and enjoy a remarkable view of the

"Golden City" of Jerusalem. Forty days after His resurrection, Jesus ascended into heaven from the Mount of Olives (Acts 1: 9-12). At Dominus Fleuit Church, which means the cry of the Lord, you will visit the place where Jesus mourned for Jerusalem, "As He saw the city, he wept over it" because "the days will come upon you when your enemies will... dash you to the ground." (Luke 19:41). Wander the excavations of the City of David.

**Nov. 15 – Masada, Qumran, Dead Sea, Valley of the Shadow**

Enjoy a visit to Masada, the spectacular mountaintop fortress built by Herod and famous as the last stronghold of the Jewish Rebellion against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore the fortress. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp below. Travel to Qumran, site of the Dead Sea Scroll discovery, to discuss the mysterious community of the Essenes who once lived on the shores of the Dead Sea. Stop at the Shores of the Dead Sea, the lowest spot on earth, where those who desire may take a quick dip in its waters. Pass through the Judean Wilderness paralleling the ancient Roman road to view the Valley of the Shadow.

**Nov. 16 - Davidson's Visitor Center, Rabbi's Tunnel, Yad Vashem, Garden Tomb, Gordon's Calvary**

Learn about present and past excavation work at the Davidson Center. Follow the Herodian Support Wall and walk on First Century pavement in the Rabbi's Tunnel. Continue to modern Jerusalem and visit the Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and be touched by its poignant images. Our final destination gives us time

to reflect on the agony of the cross at Gordon's Calvary and the exhilaration of the resurrection at the Garden Tomb.

**Nov. 17 – Depart Israel for the USA**

Return to the USA with a lifetime of memories to cherish.
